He has spent his entire career in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. ## Dr. Natalia Stapran

The Prospects of Russian Economic Projects in Southeast Asia



#### Biography

Dr. Natalia Stapran is currently Director of the Department for Multilateral Economic Cooperation and Special Projects, Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation. She is a Candidate of Historical Sciences and graduated from Moscow State Institute of International Relations (MGIMO University), School of International Relations. She was an Associate Professor at the Department of Asian and African Studies at MGIMO University and served as Director of the Russian Research Center of Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (RRC APEC) at the RANEP. She was a guest lecturer at the Higher School of Economics and other leading Russian universities. From 2000 till 2004, Dr. Natalia Stapran worked at the Russian Embassy in Tokyo (Japan). During her past years in the Ministry of Economic Development, she also served as Director of the Department for Projects' Support in the Asia-Pacific Region. She was awarded a Recognition Certificate of the President of the Russian Federation. She authored a number of academic publications and articles.

## H.E. Mohamad Wahid Supriyadi

**Book Presentation** "The Lighter and Funnier Side of Diplomacy"



#### Biography

H.E. Mohamad Wahid Supriyadi is an experienced and well-known diplomat, who has spent his entire career in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and served in a variety of appointments at home and abroad, including as Consul General in Melbourne (2004-2007), Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the United Arab Emirates (UAE) (2008-2011) and as Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to the Russian Federation and the Republic of Belarus (2016-2020). Mr. Supriyadi initiated the first Festival Indonesia in 2005 when he served as Consul General in Melbourne. This Festival later became an annual event. He also initiated a similar festival in Moscow and got MURI Award (Indonesia's Guinness Book of Records) for successfully organizing the festival successively for four times (from 2016 to 2019). Mr. Supriyadi authored a number of articles on international issues published by The Herald Sun, The Age, The Australian, Image Indonesia, Kompas Daily, Suara Pembaruan Daily, etc.

## Mr. Chris Cheang

#### Biography

Mr. Chris Cheang is an experienced and well-known diplomat, who was a Singapore Foreign Service Officer, working in various capacities in the departments dealing with the Western European countries; Southeast Asian countries; computer and information security and international economics dealing with APEC, and Singapore's Free Trade Agreements. He also served in the Singapore Embassy as the First Secretary in Bonn (1983–1987). From 1994–1997, 1999–2004 and 2006–2013, he was the First Secretary and subsequently Counsellor and Deputy Chief of Mission in the Singapore Embassy in Moscow. His last overseas assignment was between 2013 and 2017, as Singapore Consul-General in San Francisco. He has been a Senior Fellow with the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) in Singapore since October 2017. Chris is relatively fluent in the Russian language, and has an excellent command of the German language.
